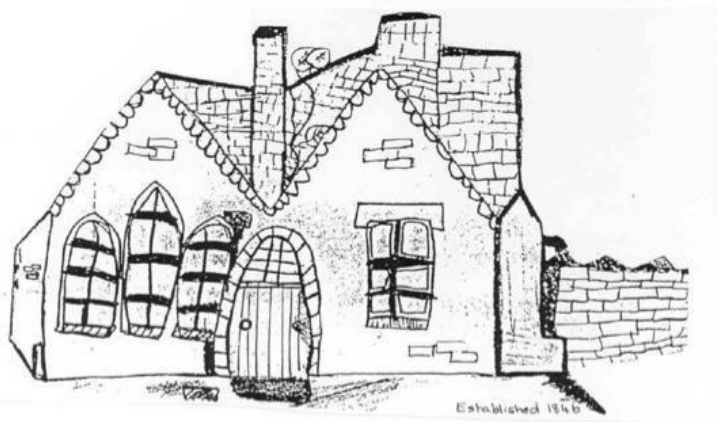


RE & Collective Worship Scripture and Bible Stories Progression of Knowledge Map
