History

How does this help you think about ourselves, others, the world and beyond?



Maths

Can you think of a moment in Maths when you felt a sense of wonder, surprise or calm? Maybe when you noticed a pattern, solved a tricky problem or saw shapes in the world around you?



Reading

Can you think of a moment in a story that you have read or listened to that made you feel surprised, comforted or confused?

How did that moment help you think about yourself, others, the world or beyond?



Writing

Can you think of a time when your writing helped you understand or express your feelings, maybe during an OW moment, a WOW moment or a NOW moment?



Science

Can you think of a time in science when you felt amazed, curious or even challenged?

How did learning about the world - big or small - help you to think about yourself, others, the world and beyond?



PSHE

Can you think of a time when you showed love, kindness or care to yourself or someone else?

How did that experience help you feel connected to yourself, others, the world or something beyond?



RE

How do stories, celebrations or spiritual practices (like prayer or reflection), help you understand yourself, the world, or something beyond? Can you think of a time when learning about religion or beliefs helped you during an OW moment?
